**Bringing the Mathematical Practices to Life in Our Classrooms**

**Kim Knighton, Profile High School**

The keynote will focus on sharing techniques and effective teaching strategies that engage students in the mathematical practices.

Kim Knighton has been teaching since 1993 and has taught grades 5-12. She is currently teaching high school mathematics at Profile School in Bethlehem, NH and serves as a Mathematics Curriculum Coordinator. Kim received the Ferd Prevost Award in March 1996 and the Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics Teaching in 2007. She's presented at state, regional, and national conferences, including two of the four high school summer institutes.

The keynote is followed by dinner and K-4, 5-8, and high school grade-level breakout explorations. NHTM Board members will facilitate the grade-level breakout sessions.
